Suspect Arrested in Double Homicide Investigation: 1500 Block of N. Mallory Street

On July 28, 2010, the Hampton Police Division arrested the suspect involved in the double homicide after he was released from the hospital.

The investigation revealed that on July 22, 2010 at 12:30 p.m., the Hampton Police Division received an e911 call regarding two people who had been shot in a home in the 1500 block of N. Mallory Street. Officers, along with members of the Hampton Fire and Rescue Division, responded to the scene and located the two victims inside the home. Both victims were pronounced deceased at the scene and died as a result of injuries sustained from being shot.

The victims have been identified as **Rebecca Jane Hall**, a 70-year-old Hampton female, and **Glen Lauren Hall, Jr.**, a 43-year-old Hampton male. Both victims reside in the 1500 block of N. Mallory Street.

The suspect has been identified as **Glen Lauren Hall, Sr.**, a 72-year-old Hampton man who resides in the 1500 block of N. Mallory Street. He has been charged with 2 counts of Murder and 2 counts of Use of a Firearm While in Commission of a Felony. The suspect is currently in the custody of the Hampton City Jail.
